Julien Montfort and Cédric Bougues-Cayre are two step-brothers working together within the exceptional Bergerac area.

Julien Montfort is running the company Julien de Savignac and owns the Clos l'Envège estate in Monbazillac that offers a wide range of wine from the Bergerac aoc: Bergerac Sec, Bergerac Rosé, Bergerac Red, Rosette, Côtes de Bergerac Blanc and Monbazillac.



Since 2008, Cédric Bougues-Cayre and Amélie Montfort are the owners of Château Briand, an old outbuilding of Château de Bridoire (XIII century). The 20 ha of Château Briand are planted of 55% of red grapes and 45% of white grapes which give powerful and elegant terroir wines.

The famous sweet white wine Cuvée Henry IV is produced at Clos l'Envège.

All these wines are retailed exclusively in restaurants and wine cellars.
